A Regulation to extend the Balochistan Development Authority Act, 1974 (Balochistan Act No. X of 1974), to the tribal areas of Balochistan.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to apply the Balochistan Development Authority Act, 1974 (Balochistan Act No. X of 1974), to the tribal areas of Balochistan:

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (4) of Article 247 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan³, the Governor of Balochistan, with the prior approval of the President, is pleased to make and promulgate the following Regulation, namely: —

Short title, extent
and
commencement.

1. (1) This Regulation may be called the Balochistan Development Authority Act (Extension to the Tribal Areas of Balochistan) Regulation, 1974.

(2) It extends to the whole of the Tribal Areas of the Province of Balochistan.

(3) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 14th January, 1974.

2. The provisions of the Balochistan Development Authority Act, 1974 (Balochistan Act No. X of 1974), and the rules made thereunder shall apply to the whole of the tribal areas of the Province of Balochistan as they apply to the other areas of the Province.
