A Regulation to provide for the transfers of certain properties in the Tribal Areas of the Province of Balochistan.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the validation of transfers of certain properties in the Tribal Areas of the Province of Balochistan.

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977³, read with the Laws (Continuance in Force) Order, 1977 (CMLA Order No. 1 of 1977)⁴, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Balochistan, with the prior approval of the President, is pleased to make the following Regulation: —

Short title, extent
and
commencement.

1. (1) This Regulation may be called the Balochistan Tribal Areas (Validation of Transfer of Properties) Regulation, 1979.

(2) It extends to the whole of the Tribal Areas of the Province of Balochistan.

(3) It shall come into force at once.

Validation of
transfers.

2. All properties transferred in the Tribal Areas of the Province of Balochistan during the years 1963 to 1973 under Scheme No. VII and revised Scheme No. VII prepared under sub-section (3) of section 10 of the Displaced Persons (Compensation and Rehabilitation) Act, 1958 (XXVIII of 1958), shall be deemed to have been validly transferred as if the said Act and Schemes were in force in those Areas at the time when the properties were so transferred.
